THE INCARNATE CHRIST

- John 1:1-10 – Enfleshment = God, who is Spirit, became flesh that we could see the attributes, character, and image of God
- He had a human body (Luke 2:52) – he felt our aches and pains
- He had a human soul & spirit (Luke 23:46) – he felt our highs and lows
- He had human characteristics:
 - HUNGER (MT. 4:2)
 - COMPASSION (MT. 9:36)
 - FATIGUE (JN. 4:6)
 - TEARS (JN. 11:35)
 - THIRST (JN. 19:28)
 - TEMPTATION (LUKE 3)



WORK OF THE FLESH

- Advocate – one called alongside; called to a person's defense
- Mediator – an ambassador; intervenes between two people
- Redeemer – ransom and payment in order to take possession from another
- Reconciler – transitioner of relationship from hostility to harmony



NECESSITY OF THE FLESH

- Genesis 3:14-15 (Romans 16:20)
- Necessary as a SACRIFICE for us to have eternal life
- Necessary for His SHED BLOOD to redeem us and destroy the devils work
