JEREMIAH'S LETTER EMPHASIS

- **SEVENTY YEARS (a divisor of seven)**
 - Seven in Scripture is symbolic for conclusion, completion, fulfillment
 - It also stands for season of time
 - It is specific not open to subjection or discussion
 - It is God's emphatic statement of duration

BUT THEN....

- God's intervention into our lives (seasons) comes with emphatic statements that only God can state or fulfill

A PROMISE IS A PROMISE

- **The subjection and objective of good** (Rom. 8:28)
- **A promise from God is more than what we promise**

PROMISES, PROMISES

- **Home Again, Home Again**
- **A concluding sentence of a recurring action**
 - The implication from God is that He has fulfilled promises before whether we acknowledged them or not; thus if He's done it before, He'll do it again, and again, and again, and again!

IN THE END...

- Summation of the Emphatic Sentence
 - “No matter how long the season, God will intervene when everything is in its rightful place; at which time His presence will provide the perfect outcome and fulfillment of His word, which He’s done many times before!”
